HELPFUL HINT OF THE DAY

Focus on learning your children's names

- **Read the question and paragraph**
- **Story of Martha and Mary**
 - Talk about the questions: What was Mary longing for?**
 - Why do you think Jesus said her choice was better?**

The Gift of Longing

- **Read paragraphs.**
- **Do Optional Activity on Top Ten List (bottom of page 65)**

What God Gives

- **Read paragraph**
- **Read Scripture section**
- **Ask: Why do you think Jesus chose the image of water in his teaching?**
- **Activity – Woman at the Well Puzzle**

God Satisfies you

- **Read paragraph.**
- **Discuss faith words.**

Helping Faith Grow

- **Ask children practical steps that would help them increase their faith.**
Write suggestions on white board
- **Activity – Break into small groups and do the Connect your Faith section.**
- **Share the poems with the class**

TIP

Our Catholic Life

- **Read question and paragraphs.**
- **Encourage children to share places where they go to seek God and pray.**
- **Ask: What would help you be a better listener when you pray?**

People of Faith

- **Read about St. Augustine**
- **Do Catholic social teaching on Call to Family, Community, and Participation on pg 292 – 293.**

Can do Live Your Faith Activity

Take Homes:

- **Remind children to share Family and Faith with their parents**

Complete the puzzle below by filling in the spaces with the correct responses to the numbered clues.

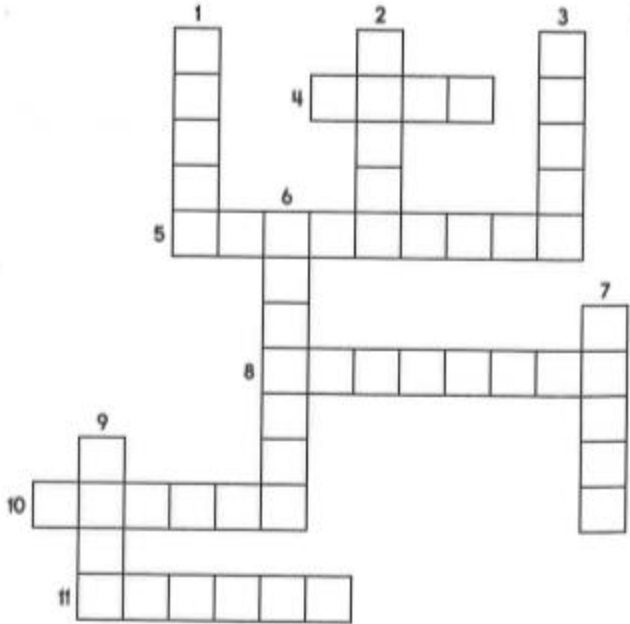
