Other Requirements

We ask all students to attend ***at least one Confirmation retreat*** during their two-year period of Confirmation preparation. Potential options include:

- Frassati Fest
- NCYC (every other year – offered in fall 2021)
- Camp Gray Confirmation Retreats
- Together Encountering Christ (TEC) Retreats
- Saint Alberts Retreat (Spring 2021)

Every student needs to select a ***Confirmation sponsor***.

- Your sponsor needs to be a confirmed Catholic who is actively practicing the Catholic faith. You may select a sibling to be your sponsor, but you cannot choose your own parent as your Confirmation sponsor. Your Confirmation sponsor should be someone who you look to as a role model and a mentor in your faith life.
