- Quote from Pope Benedict XVI on Lent

“Lent is like a long ‘retreat’ during which we can turn back into ourselves and listen to the voice of God, in order to defeat the temptations of the Evil One. It is a period of spiritual ‘combat’ which we must experience alongside Jesus, not with pride and presumption, but using the arms of faith: prayer, listening to the word of God and penance. In this way we will be able to celebrate Easter in truth, ready to renew the promises of our Baptism.”

TIP

Let us Pray

- **Our Father and Hail Mary**
- **Read God's word section (pg. 37)**
- **Ask the what do you Wonder questions.**

STEP 3 – DISCOVER

TIP

Making Sacrifices (pg. 244)

- **Ask: What sacrifice did Jesus make for us?**
- **Read paragraph**
- **Read God's word (pg. 244)**
- **Talk about the last time the children had to give up something for someone else. Refer to the pictures for examples.**

The Greatest Gift

- **Read paragraphs**
- **Ask the children to describe the wonderful thing that happened to Jesus three days after his death.**
- **Ask the children how we remember and celebrate Jesus' Death and Resurrection. If the children mention Easter, explain to them that we celebrate a "little Easter" every Sunday at Mass.**

Activity – My Prayer of Thanks sheet

- **Ask: What will the gifts of bread and wine become during the Mass?**
- **Read the paragraphs.**

Activity – Do the Connect your faith section.

STEP 4 – LIVE

Our Catholic Life

- **Ask: How do you remember Jesus's sacrifice at Mass?**
- **Read paragraphs**
- **Talk about the Mystery of Faith**
- **Tell the children the information on the mystery of faith from the quick tip section. (The word mystery comes from the Greek word mysterion, which means "a truth whispered". In the Church, it is used to describe truths of faith that are beyond human understanding.**
- **Turn to pg. 311 and find the Mystery of Faith and when it happens in the Order of the Mass**
- **Can also review what happens in the Liturgy of the Word section of the mass and what happens in the Liturgy of the Eucharist section.**

Easter: Talk about Easter and why it is important. (pg. 43 and 44)

Read the What is Easter sheet.

Optional: Can read an Easter book

Talk about Blessed Imelda Lambertini





