# **Lesson 15 - Help with Choices**

Grade 3 – Chapter 15 and Lent

#### KEY CONCEPT

Conscience is the ability given to us by God that helps us make choices about right and wrong. God's grace in the Sacraments, and the Holy Spirit, help us make changes and good choices.

#### HELPFUL HINT OF THE DAY

### **Always Address the "so what?" Question**

- The tradition, doctrines, scripture and heritage we possess sit in a vacuum if they are not connected with real life experiences
- -There is always a "why" behind each teaching of the Faith
- These are the most important things to explain to our youth because that is when true learning happens. They are able to connect it with a reason instead of just being told what to do
- Don't pass up opportunities to address these questions. If left unanswered, the lesson will be forgotten by the kids by the time they get into the car to go home!
- If you don't the "why" behind a teaching, just ask! None of us are perfect to have each answer but that's why we are called to community with those around to help each of us learn more.

#### **The Church Guides Choices**

- Read paragraphs.
- Talk about Precepts of the Church

#### **Changing Directions**

- Ask the question: How do you overcome making a bad choice?
- Read paragraph

#### Read God's Word section.

 Ask the children how Saul changed. Remind the children that people who make selfish choices can change and make better choices. (tell them about scripture background on pg. 212

#### The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation

 Read paragraphs (Refer to the information in the margin to distinguish between a sin and an accident or mistake. The choice to sin is intentional but an accident or a mistake is not intentional)

#### **Activity -Do the Connect your Faith activity**

Talk about the Stations of the Cross and about how they portray what happened to Jesus before he died on the cross and rose again.

# The Temptation of Jesus

#### A CHORUS PLAY BASED ON MATTHEW 4:1-11

Chorus plays are a type of Gospel Drama that present scriptural stories in the form of a play with both individual characters and a chorus. The chorus allows for a whole-group participation.

People required: Leader, Voice, Chorus. It might be helpful to have an additional reader read the designated "Chorus" lines and then have the rest of the children echo that reader.



Leader: From Matthew's Gospel:
