Meeting was called to order by Ben Quint. Mission statement was read. Minutes of the November meeting were approved by consensus.

**Old Business:**

St. Patrick Hall bathrooms: Lial and the committee has put a tremendous amount of time into planning the new bathrooms. Many ideas were looked into and the finalized plans include a new men's and women's bathroom, and a room added to the south of the restrooms for a built in bar. Pictures are available in the back of church to show how the extra addition to the east side of the gym spanning from the doors past the second window to the south will look when finished. The heating cooling will be separate for the bathrooms. Demolition help will be appreciated. Gina made a motion to move forward on the St. Patrick Hall bathroom, Tony seconded it, 8 members voted yes, no one voted no.

- The Council has voted to proceed with a revised Hall renovation consisting of a men's and women's restroom along with a bar area.
- Estimated cost of the project is \$94,000.
- Funds are available from the sale of S.P.S.O.R. (\$39,600), Louis/Mary Ryan Memorial (\$25,000), and Social Circle (\$30,000).
- The project will begin in April.
- Donations can be made with the memo St. Pat's Hall Renovations.

The stained glass window from the original church, donated back to St. Pat's from the Kraus family is believed to have come from one of the side windows. The lighted window will be hung over the east entry double doors as you enter the church. A beautiful display case has been built, the wiring is still in progress but the goal is to have an unveiling of the window on March 11th, immediately after mass.

**New Business:**

Minutes will be put into bulletins within a month of the council meetings.

Upcoming Elections: We need names for people to run for church council. If you are interested please contact a board member. Council meets 4 times a year.
