Hannah reported things are winding down for the year. Confirmation completed, summer session is a new option in August.

Old Business:

Additional handicap parking at the church was again discussed. Joellyn reported Tony did some research and to add 4 additional handicap spaces in the same area as the existing spaces total cost would be approximately \$10,000. After discussion, motion was made by Christy, second by Gina to move forward with this project. Motion carried.

New Business:

Welcome Monica Kehrli to the Pastoral Council meeting. David O'Brien will also be contacted as we need to replace Ben Quint and Tony Helmrich on the Council. Thank you to Ben and Tony for their years of service to the Parish.

Wages for Parish staff were reviewed. Father Joe made a motion to approve a 4% increase, Gina second. Motion carried.

Budget for 2018-2019 was reviewed. Motion by Christy, second by Joyce to approve. Motion carried.

'Installation of Pastor' for Father Gabriel Anderson, by Archbishop Jackels, will be August 5, 2018 after 10am mass in Manchester. Father Gabriel wanted to make sure all Councils are aware of this and invited to attend.

Robo Woods, Calvary Cemetery trustee, spoke to Council regarding the cemetery and improvements that need to be done. The cemetery has been given a donation to remove and plant new trees. Robo is having a hard time finding someone willing to do this. There is a total of 40 trees. After much discussion, Robo will continue to do some research. He is also looking for an additional trustee. We have had 3 cemetery trustees in the past.

Financial Committee: We reviewed financials through fiscal year April 2018. We are staying close to budget but giving is consistently down during Saturday evening masses. This will be discussed with Father Gabriel.
