COVID Safety Measures

The Archdiocese of Dubuque has provided guidance/safety protocols for parishes/clusters that are hosting Totus Tuus in the summer of 2021. Considering that we are still living in a global pandemic, Archbishop Jackels has made the following statement:

“With regard to Church-sponsored activities, (Mass and meetings, school and RE activities, just to name a few), the public health safety measures will continue to be observed until the COVID-19 vaccine is available to all who are able to receive it, and the CDC announces that the pandemic is under control”.

To keep our students, missionaries, staff and volunteers as safe as possible and to maximize our chances of offering an uninterrupted summer of Totus Tuus to parishes throughout the diocese, the following measures will be implemented (based on the current virus data at this time). It is subject to change as the situation warrants:

- Masking will be required for all students, staff, missionaries, and volunteers while in attendance at Totus Tuus
- Sanitizing stations will be set up throughout the facility
- We will practice the recommended distancing guidelines whether in the classroom or while eating or drinking
- As always, we will ask that all participants, staff, missionaries and volunteers monitor their health throughout the week and if symptoms associated with COVID-19 arise to err on the side of caution and stay home until symptoms subside.
