LAST CALL: March for Life Trip to Washington, DC, Jan. 26-28, 2017: The annual March for Life will be held Friday, January 27 in protest of the Supreme Court's Roe vs. Wade decision that legalized abortion in the United States. We will be leaving Danville on a chartered bus early Thursday morning, January 26 and returning on Saturday evening, January 28. We will stay two nights at the Hampton Inn, Alexandria, Virginia. While in Washington, we will participate in Mass at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception on Thursday evening, the 26th and the March for Life on Friday, January 27. John Durbin, a career courier with the government and a former St. Luke Parishioner, will be our tour guide for our free time.

Your cost for the trip will be: \$280 each for a double room, and \$240 each for 3-4 persons in a room. Final payment is due on January 10th. Please make checks payable to St. Luke Parish.
