**Update of Church Renovations:** The pews have been removed and are being stored in a climate-controlled facility. The stained-glass windows have been cleaned and are covered. Plaster has been prepped and repair work is almost done. They have started priming. The ceiling in the choir loft is painted as well as the rib work and around the rose window. It looks beautiful. The confessional is being prepped. Weekly payments are being made with a deposit on flooring, pew covering, and artist for the artwork. There are 7 men working and they are on schedule!
