Budget: Year to date through December was shared and is on target with no unexpected expenditures.

Facility Update: Wayne Carlisle- New vents and controllers installed to alleviate heat issue in downstairs classrooms.

Legacy of Faith/New Church Update: Wayne Carlisle- Construction scheduled to begin mid-April. Wayne shared the plans for new church. Recommendations were made that long-time parishioners/alumni be involved in the planning and design of the chapel in the old church.

Carnival Update: Wayne Carlisle- New this year: Reduced number of volunteer hours, streamlined set-up and tear down, basketball tournament in lieu of rummage to bring more families to the event.

Service Update: January: Catholic Charities collection, NJHS at CC to stock the shelves, individual grade level projects.

Enrollment Update: Current- 695(class size 25-32) Open enrollment continues strong with wait list for 2020 in the following: ELC, PREK, Kindergarten, Third, Fifth

PTA Update: Oyster Roast should clear about \$68,000. Possible allocation to paving the parking area in the front of the school.

Faculty Update: Faculty requests upgraded printers.

Development Committee: Selection/Invitation process complete. Dates for the first meeting TBA. The first meeting will provide an overview of financials of past fundraising events. What can we do better? Additionally, how do we implement and sustain a strong annual giving fund.
