TALENT SHOW APPLICATION

On April 24, 2020, the students of Visitation of Our Lady School will come out to the Cajun Fest to showcase their talent. This event will be open to all students in 1st through 7th grades. Judges will evaluate each performance on its originality, preparation, appropriateness, talent and presentation. Prizes will be awarded for various categories.

Talent Show Act Requirements:

- All acts must be no longer than 3 minutes.
- Each act/group must pay an entrance fee of \$20.00.
- Tickets will be sold for all family and friends to come out and enjoy. Cost of tickets are \$5.00.
- Participants must provide all props. Exception: a microphone and gym mat will be available.
- All music/dance moves/costumes/other entertainment must be appropriate and family friendly.
- You may do a group performance, but all group members must sign the form and be willing to participate.

Talent Show Guidelines:

- Performers **MUST** be present for rehearsal and show. Exceptions will be made on an individual basis for health concerns and other emergency situations. Sporting events and other outside event rehearsals do not count as “emergency situations.” If you cannot make the time commitment, please do not register. You will be removed from the show if you miss a scheduled rehearsal.
- Dates are as follows:
 - Tuesday, April 21..After School Dress Rehearsal -3:30 pm
 - Friday, April 24...**Talent Show!** Report by 6:30, show begins promptly @ 7pm
- After completing the entire application (including parent signature), return the application to the school office on or before **April 8th**.
- Due to allergies & safety concerns, no animals are allowed as a part of performance.
- Music must be supplied on a CD and clearly labeled. There cannot be any explicit or inappropriate language in the music. Music must be turned in with the application on or before April 8th.
- **Winner(s) will perform in front of the main stage on Sunday, April 26th at 5 pm**
