VOL Cajun Festival Committee members have taken the past year to evaluate Cajun Festival and come up with new and exciting ways to raise funds. Most importantly, we need your involvement. Whether time, talent, or suggestion, your assistance will be a benefit to Cajun Festival.

Our goal is focused on working together. We will no longer have one small committee responsible for all festival components. While this has worked for us in the past, our festival has gotten too big for such a small committee. Instead, we are building several subcommittees. Each subcommittee will be responsible for one component of the festival. While we have leaders who have volunteered to chair some of these committees already, we are still looking for more volunteers. You don't have to be a subcommittee chair to be on a subcommittee. Any time you can commit, in any capacity is never too much or too little. Our hope is to bring fresh ideas and positive change. We would like to invite all of you to help us with this new structure.

Purpose of Cajun Festival: Funds raised by VOL Cajun Festival go directly to help offset the mortgage we continue to pay on Padre Hall II (also known as the gym). The mortgage balance is \$2.7M. VOL began plans for the multi-purpose building in 2005 with approval from VOL School Board, Finance Council, Pastoral Council and the Archdiocese. VOL committed 100% of the proceeds from Cajun Festival be allocated to paying the mortgage of this building (in addition to other commitments). The building provides the school with classroom facilities, pre-k facilities, gymnasium, staging and other amenities. It has been an asset to the school and parish. Once the mortgage debt is paid off, Cajun Festival will provide funds to enhance the school and parish in technology, infrastructure, and other needs.
