

**Deacon Tom Kaldy** is in his 21st year of teaching and his ninth year at Good Shepherd Catholic School. He has taught both 5th grade and 3rd grade at GSCS and is now the Religion teacher for multiple grades. In addition, he was an elementary school teacher for twelve years in the public school system teaching grades two through five. He has been married for forty-seven years to LouAnna (Hornbeck). They have two daughters, Candice and Cheryl, and four grand-children. Deacon Tom and his wife are native Kentuckians from Covington. Deacon Tom has a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education from the University of Kentucky and a Master's Degree in Elementary Education from Indiana University. He is a Rank II teacher licensed to teach in both Kentucky and Indiana. Deacon Tom is also a military veteran serving eleven years on active duty in the United States Marine Corps and seventeen years in the Kentucky Army National Guard. He served thirteen of his years in the Guard as a full-time employee of the federal government. He has been exposed to various cultures spending time in Japan, Okinawa, Korea, Hong Kong, Egypt, England, and the Philippines. Deacon Tom was ordained a Permanent Deacon in 2012 and is assigned to Good Shepherd Parish.
