Dear GSCS Parents,

I have gathered some important information for you:

- Our last of day of school will be **Thursday, May 21** for **Preschool-7th**. (**8th grade** last day of school will be **Friday, May 15**).
- Next **Friday, May 1st** will be a drive by for all students/parents from **10:30 until noon** in the school parking lot. During this time you can pick up lunch & breakfast too. There will be 2 bins by the front of school to return **library books** and another for **sports uniforms**. Come join the fun!
- **Friday, May 15** from 11:00 to 11:30 to say good bye to our 8th graders as they drive by school.
- **Tuesday, May 19 from 10:30 to 11:30** and from **4:30-5:30** will be a pick up in the parking for your students' belongings. The teachers will have them in big plastic bags with your family name on them. The bags will be in sections identified from A-Z in the main parking lot.
- **Thursday, May 21, from 11:00 to Noon**, all faculty and staff will be in standing 6-10 feet apart in the front of school to wave goodbye to our students and families.
- **Book return** will also be on **Thursday, May 21 from 11:00 to Noon**. There will be a table with grade levels marked to return all hard bound books.
- Graduation will take place the week before we start school in the fall. More information will be coming closer to the date.
- Report cards will be available for viewing and printing on Friday, May 22 on MSP. If you do not have a means to print the report card please notify your student's homeroom teacher.

- Make sure your student has all their assignments finished. Possibility of retention or summer school is a reality.
- Unfortunately we will not have any summer camps this year. With the uncertainty of the COVID-19, we did not want to start camp and then possibly have to close it.
- This one you will love...there will not be any summer work for our students other than some math practice skills to keep them sharp.
