Propers for Today's Mass: Propers for Pentecost Sunday begin on page 295 of the Campion Missal/Hymnal.

Parish Erection & Confirmations: Bishop Anthony Taylor is coming on **Saturday, June 24th** to turn our community into a parish! The ceremony and Mass will begin at **2pm**. The Bishop has asked that Confirmation be at that time on June 24th, not on June 11th. This is a great relief considering the crowded schedule in the new place. Fr. Brodsky will be coming to assist with the ceremonies and celebrate the wonderful day. All are strongly encouraged to attend.

First Communion and First Confession: First Communicants need to be tested before June 11th. The child needs to receive his First Confession before Sunday, June 18th First Communion Day. I will be happy to answer any parents' questions.

Confirmation Test: Confirmandi need to be tested by today June 4th.

Gatherings after both Sunday Masses: All are welcome after the Sunday Masses. We will serve coffee after every Sunday Mass from now on. Children should not use the Hall which contains construction material.

Corpus Christi and First Communion: June 18th is the External Solemnity of Corpus Christi. Children will be receiving their First Communion at Mass on this day. The 10:45am Mass will be followed by a procession and Benediction at three outside altars. A reception for the First Communicants will follow and all are invited to attend.
