**Building Project News:** Our local architect has completed our architectural survey, which includes drawings and a report of his findings and recommendations. While continuing toward a master plan for the entire project, the next step is a plan for the work of repairing existing damage to the roof, eaves and soffits, and establishing effective drainage for the entire property. This repair and drainage plan is expected within this month of November.

**The Rosary Makers' Guild** made 63 rosaries in October, and 6 others were donated, providing 69 rosaries to be sent to the missions. Thanks to all who have donated to support the guild.
