**Proper for Today's Mass:** The texts proper to today's Mass begin on page 410 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

**Second Collection** today is for the Building Fund.

**Handmaids of the Lord** are meeting today at 1:00pm (after the 10:45am Mass) in the choir room to discuss Christmas decorating and other business.

**The Sacrament of Confirmation** will be conferred by His Excellency, Bishop Taylor, on Saturday, December 1, 11:00 am, with a reception to follow. In addition to the regular 8:00 am mass that day, a mass will be offered at 9:00 am, with attendance asked of those to be confirmed and their sponsors, and open to all others. A rehearsal for the ceremony will follow mass, before the bishop's arrival.

**Advent Day of Recollection:** On Saturday, December 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, there will be a day of recollection, one of silent retreat in preparation for Christmas. The day will begin with mass at 8 am, and will include spiritual conferences, recitation of the Rosary, and opportunities for confession, concluding by about 3:00 pm. A light breakfast will follow mass, and a simple lunch will be served at about noon. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A donation of \$5.00 is asked for the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.
