**Proper for Today's Mass:** The texts proper to today's Mass begin on page 91 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

**Ash Wednesday:** Ashes will be blessed and distributed at each mass, 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Please remember that this is a day of fast and abstinence (see next announcement.)

**Laws of Abstinence and Fast:** Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

**Ash Wednesday Special Collection:** The Ash Wednesday Collection supports the evangelization mission of the Church in Arkansas. This includes providing priests, religious, and lay personnel to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ, as they serve among the people of our diocese who lack the financial resources to support fully the priests, religious and lay personnel who serve them.

**Stations of the Cross** will be held every Friday of Lent, beginning this Friday, March 8. Stations will be at 7:15 pm, except on Good Friday, when they will be at 2:00 pm.

**Additional Mass on Fridays:** On an experimental basis, a 12:00 pm mass will be offered on Fridays, in addition to the usual 6:30 pm mass.

**A Lenten Day of Recollection** will be given on Saturday, March 23, a day of silent retreat for Lent. The day will begin with mass at 8 am, and will include spiritual conferences, recitation of the Rosary, and opportunities for confession, concluding by about 3:00 pm. A light breakfast will follow mass, and a simple lunch will be served at about noon. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A donation of \$5.00 is asked for the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.

**Monthly Brunch has been moved from March 10 to March 17** so that we may celebrate St. Patrick's Day. The theme is of course Irish dishes which include potato, cabbage, and corn beef recipes. Or just bring something green such as green Jell-o, but no green eggs and ham, please.
