Proper for Today's Mass: The texts proper to today's Mass begin on page 105 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

Additional Mass on Fridays: On an experimental basis, a 12:00 pm mass will be offered on Fridays, in addition to the usual 6:30 pm mass.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday of Lent, beginning this Friday, March 8. Stations will be at 7:15 pm, except on Good Friday, when they will be at 2:00 pm.

Collection for Support of FSSP Seminary: On Sunday, March 17, there will be a second collection; its purpose will be the support of Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary, the Fraternity's seminary in North America. Your contribution will make possible the training of your future priests; please give generously! There are envelopes available in the vestibule.

A Lenten Day of Recollection will be given on Saturday, March 23, a day of silent retreat for Lent. The day will begin with mass at 8 am, and will include spiritual conferences, recitation of the Rosary, and opportunities for confession, concluding by about 3:00 pm. A light breakfast will follow mass, and a simple lunch will be served at about noon. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A donation of \$5.00 is asked for the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.

Monthly Brunch has been moved from March 10 to March 17 so that we may celebrate St. Patrick's Day. The theme is of course Irish dishes which include potato, cabbage, and corn beef recipes. Or just bring something green such as a salad.

Please Call your State Senator: The Arkansas Senate Education Committee recently passed Senate Bill 304 (S.B. 304), which would require all public junior high and high schools in Arkansas to offer "evidence based" health courses to 7th - 12th graders; the phrase "evidence based" is a euphemism for "sexually explicit." **Your state senator could vote on S.B. 304 very soon.
