Proper for Today's Mass: The texts proper to today's Mass begin on page 125 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday of Lent, beginning this Friday, March 8. Stations will be at 7:15 pm, except on Good Friday, when they will be at 2:00 pm.

Prayer for an End to Infanticide: The U.S. Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities has published the following prayer: "Jesus, Lord of Life, transform the hearts of all elected leaders to recognize that infanticide is wrong and must not be tolerated. Open hearts and minds to recognize and defend the precious gift of human life."

Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Both abstinence and fast are serious obligations. Abstinence obliges from one's fourteenth birthday, and requires abstention from meat, and from soup or gravy made from meat. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting obliges those aged 18 to 59, inclusively, and allows one full meal, and as many as two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal. According to current Church law, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

Progress with Church Renovation Project: We plan to present our first submittal to the Diocesan Building Commission on Tuesday, April 23. This is the first, formal step in gaining the Bishop's approval for a building project. Please continue to keep in your prayers the intention that God's will be done in these matters!
