Proper for Today's Mass: The texts for the Sunday Mass may be found on page 295 in the *St. Edmund Campion Missal & Hymnal*.

No Masses this Monday through Saturday, June 10-15. Both priests will be in Nebraska for their annual retreat.

The Duty of Annual Confession: Separate from the Easter Duty of Communion, a Catholic having made first confession is obliged to make a sacramental confession once per year, though at no specified time.

The Easter Duty of Holy Communion: According to the Commandments of the Church, Catholics having already made First Holy Communion are seriously obliged to make a worthy Communion at least once during the Easter time. For the purposes of fulfilling this duty, that time is between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday (next Sunday), inclusively.

Progress with Church Renovation Project: This past week, parishioners volunteered the necessary labor and time to gain access to, and to photograph, the supporting structure of the church roof. (Its design had been, until now, a matter of speculation for the architect, as there were no drawings available for the existing building.) The initial assessment is encouraging, as the structure appears to be in good shape. During this week and next week, a group of sweet-gum trees will be removed from the rear of the church, as well as the partially-dead one in front. (Fr. McCambridge regrets the loss of shade!) All are being removed to eliminate the risk of their damaging the church.

Clean-up after Sunday Hospitality: There are many who enjoy the social time and refreshments following the 10:45 Mass on Sundays, but the clean-up is almost always accomplished by the same few. Father McCambridge has posted a sign-up list in the Social Hall for volunteers to assist with clean-up. It should go without saying that all who partake (other than young children) ought to share in the work. Thank you!
