We presented our project as currently proposed (as presented to parishioners on August 4), especially with the hope of obtaining a cost estimate for our proposed renovations. Once that estimate is available, we will refine our plans as necessary, and, hopefully, be ready to make a second submittal to the Diocesan Building Commission in November.
