ANNOUNCEMENTS AND EVENTS

Ash Wednesday: Ashes will be blessed and distributed at each mass, 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Please remember that this is a day of fast and abstinence.

Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Current Church law obliges **abstinence** from meat, and soup or gravy made from meat, for those aged 14 & up, and **fasting** (one full meal and two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal) for those aged 18 to 59, inclusively. Additionally, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, and Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.

Lenten Day of Recollection: On Saturday, March 14, there will be a day of recollection silent retreat in preparation for Easter. The day will begin with mass at 8am followed by a light breakfast. The day will include spiritual conferences, opportunities for confession, a light lunch, and will conclude by about 3pm. Please sign up on the list in the vestibule. A \$5.00 donation is requested to assist in covering the cost of meals; envelopes for this purpose are available near the sign-up list, and may be submitted in the box outside the Church Office.

Ash Wednesday Special Collection: This collection supports the evangelization mission of the Church in Arkansas: providing priests, religious, and lay personnel to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ, as they serve among those less fortunate in our diocese.

Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday during Lent, beginning this Friday, February 28. Stations will be at 7:15 pm, except on Good Friday, when they will be at 2:00 pm.

Lenten Plenary Indulgence: On Fridays during the season of Lent, a plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who, after Communion, recite the Prayer Before a Crucifix before an image of Christ Crucified. The prayer can be found on page 65 of the red booklet missals.
