ANNOUNCEMENTS AND EVENTS

Laws of Abstinence and Fast: Current Church law obliges **abstinence** from meat, and soup or gravy made from meat, for those aged 14 & up, and **fasting** (one full meal and two smaller meals, which together do not equal a full meal) for those aged 18 to 59, inclusively. Additionally, Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, and Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast.
