**Progress with Church Renovation:** Despite the temporary diversion of dealing with concern over the coronavirus, our plans for construction are advancing. Progress is being made toward choosing a general contractor and obtaining artist’s renderings of the planned design. More news soon!

**Assistance at Masses:** The faithful remain dispensed of the obligation of assisting at Holy Mass for the time being. When attending mass or visiting the church, please observe all required precautions to minimize the risk of contagion.

**A Plenary Indulgence** may be gained by saying the *Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus* publicly in front of the Blessed Sacrament on Friday, June 19, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. (All necessary general conditions for gaining indulgences must be also met.)

**Communications with Parish Office and Pastor:** Routine communications with the parish, whether by phone, email, or written correspondence, should please be made, as much as possible, through the Parish Office. This means calling the Parish Office, rather than Father's cell phone, and emailing the Parish Secretary, Mrs. Amori Nauman, rather than the Pastor. When seeking to speak or meet with Father, contact should be made through the Parish Office; the office hours are on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, 9:30 am - 2:00 pm. It is always possible to leave a message by phone; Father checks the messages daily. When arranging appointments or calls with a priest, one should not mention anything confidential, personal, or sensitive to anyone but the priest. For example, one wishing to arrange a time for Confession should not disclose that in a message, but simply ask for a call from Father. Concerning text messaging: please refrain from sending text messages to the Pastor unless your business is both important and urgent, and the Parish Secretary is unavailable. Thank you for your kind consideration; God bless you!

**Daily Masses:** With this week's return of the Tuesday mass to 6:30 pm, all weekday masses are now returned to their regularly scheduled times. Please note that the faithful are welcome to attend daily Mass, as well as Sunday Mass.
