## Welcoming and Supporting Refugees in Delaware

Jewish Family Services of Delaware (JFS), the  
only refugee resettlement agency in the state of  
Delaware, is in close and consistent contact with  
state officials and national partners  
at HIAS regarding our state's response to the  
crisis in Afghanistan.

JFS' RISE team and staff are scaling up and  
preparing to provide support for **10 Afghan  
families or up to 30 people between now and  
early 2022**. These numbers are in addition to the  
50 refugees JFS was already planning to receive  
throughout the year from locations around the  
world (In August, JFS welcomed a Rwandan  
family of 3; this month, we are anticipating a  
family of 5 from Jordan.)
