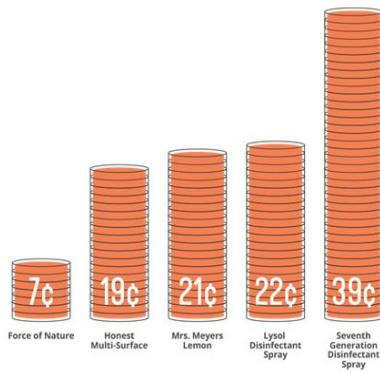

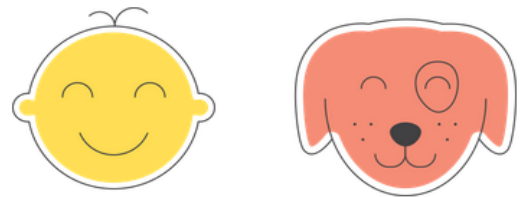
We sized our spray bottle at 12 oz. so that you can easily use it up within two weeks. The bonus? No more wasteful single use plastic bottles!

- #1** Fragrance chemicals can pass through the skin and enter the blood stream. They are classified as carcinogens, hormone disruptors, neurotoxins, skin and respiratory irritants.
- #2** Get this one: the fragrance industry is self-regulated. Safety testing does not have to precede product sales, and fragrance "cocktails" don't require reviews by regulatory agencies.
- #3** Fragrances are considered "trade secrets" so manufacturers aren't required to disclose the potentially hundreds of ingredients hiding behind the ambiguous word, fragrance. Terms like natural fragrance, fragrance-free or unscented can also be misleading.
