

The Mount Horeb Area Food Pantry plans to remain open. We have temporarily rescinded all of our income guidelines. Therefore, we are allowing anyone who lives within the Mount Horeb Area School District to come in to get food twice a month until further notice.

We have pre-selected items ready to hand out, or they may call the Pantry (437-7887) to place an order, and we will go over items that are currently available that they can choose from. In the event that they do not reach someone when calling, they should leave a message for a volunteer to call them back. Orders need to be placed by Thursday for pick-up on Saturday or Monday (whichever they choose).

For the safety of everyone, we have implemented curbside pick-up. Therefore, when people come, we ask that they stay in their vehicle and a volunteer will go talk to them. We will bring their groceries out to their vehicle (no need to come into the pantry). The pantry is located at 102 E. Lincoln St. in Mount Horeb. We are open on Saturdays from 10:00 am to Noon and Mondays from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. We are also willing to work out delivery for those who may need that service.

Second, since we are still open to service the people in the Mount Horeb area, we ask for continued donations. We have a few options for monetary donations. Checks can be mailed to the Mount Horeb Area Food Pantry at PO Box 204; Mount Horeb, WI 53572 or dropped off in person during our open hours.
