Important news to St. Michael the Archangel Parishioners, as we transition to the re-opening of our Churches on May 30th!

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Masses will resume this weekend, May 30 & 31 at 50 person maximum per Mass.

You will notice changes to the Mass schedule and appearance.

An additional Mass has been added to the Mass schedule on Sunday's at 5:00 pm at St. Ignatius.

With the intent of protecting our elderly and children, in particular, we would like to ask you to attend Mass by category, if at all possible.

Sat. 5 pm: elderly parishioners and their caregivers and those with compromised immune systems;

Sun. 8 am: Holy Redeemer members only;

Sun. 10:30 am: families with children;

Sun. 5pm: all others.

We will not be using greeters, song leaders, servers, sacristans or gift bearers at this time.

Offertory collections will not be taken up in the pew. Rather a basket will be placed at entrances for you to place your donation in either before or after Mass.

NO singing is to be allowed at this time. We will have musicians only.

Only every other pew will be available to help to maintain social distancing.

Ushers will release pew by pew for Communion and one side at a time, as people need to maintain the 6 foot social distancing guideline.

Please remain in your pew until the usher's dismiss your pew at the end of Mass.

Please do not congregate in the church or parking lot before or after Mass.

If you are an usher, reader or Eucharistic Minister and would like to serve the parish during this transition, please call the office and leave a message which Mass you would be willing to serve at.

Masses will continue to be live streamed for those who cannot attend in person.
