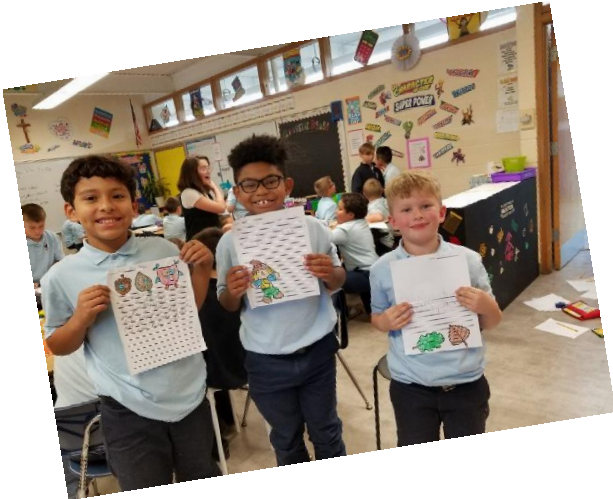
Unit 4 Vocabulary Words:
