During the month of October, we will continue to strive to do our best.

Handwriting- We will be concentrating on writing lowercase letters. Also, we will be learning each letter in sign language. The children will learn two to three words with each new letter learned.

Phonics/Spelling- We will be focusing on short vowel sounds. Have your child sing the vowel song!

Language Arts- We will continue to work on sentence structure and be writing a personal narrative. We will use literature as a springboard for speaking and writing.

Religion- The children will understand that there are many ways to praise God and through Baptism we become children of God and Christians.

Math- We are working on the concept of addition. The students will use pictures, counters, symbols, and numbers to add. Try Fact Dash at home!

Reading- The students work in a small and large group every day. We focus on fluency, comprehension, vocabulary, phonics, and literary skills. The children will participate in Readers' Theater. It is a wonderful way for the children to practice and master their reading skills. The class is divided into groups and assigned reading parts. We will concentrate on reading in a manner that sounds like natural speech, rate and volume. The children will create a backdrop and perform in other classrooms in the primary building.
