Dear Parents,

If I have received a communication from you about the status of your account and your intentions for payment, I will note that on your letter. As I have stated, Father Patrick and I recognize that some families have experienced a financial hardship during this uncertain time. We would like to work with you as needed to fulfill your tuition obligation. We can make arrangements to continue your payments through the summer as needed, but the important part is that I must have communication from you on the status of your payments. *Families of 8th grade students must have their tuition accounts paid in full in order to have your child participate in the graduation ceremony planned for this summer or to receive his/her diploma.*
