USED UNIFORM



The used uniform sale will begin on Monday, May 24 starting at 8:30 a.m. and run through Thursday, May 27 You may bring any uniform items you wish to sell to the foyer anytime on Friday, May 21, or on May 24. **Items for the uniform sale must be in good shape and be part of the current school uniform. Items that are not suitable, not in good condition, or do not fit the uniform requirements will be removed from the sale.**

Pants should be folded and will be placed on tables. All other items should be on hangers. Pin an envelope with your name and the price of the item on every piece of clothing you bring to sell. Stating the size on the price tag is very helpful. The sale is run on the honor system. If you wish to purchase something, remove the envelope and place your money inside. Place your payment in the box in the office and it will be forwarded to the correct person. **Please bring small bills with you to the sale. The office will not have any money available to make change.** The sale will run until Thursday, May 27 at 3:00. All unsold items must be picked up on Friday. Anything remaining after Friday will be donated to charity.

If you are coming to the uniform sale, please remember that parking is not allowed in the circle drive in the morning before school begins and parents will not be allowed into the building before 8:30 a.m. Masks must be worn at all times you are in the building.
