One Bread, One Cup is a five-day liturgical leadership conference focusing on the Word, Sacrament, and Mission of the Roman Catholic Church for high school youth and their campus and youth ministers. Conferences focus on community building, leadership development, catechesis, liturgical and spiritual formation, and theological reflection. High school youth participants must have completed 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade

\$650 (\$550 for the conference and \$100 for travel)



Would There be fundraising?

We ask participants to pay a minimum of half the cost of the trip and fundraise the other half. For families who are able to pay the entire amount, without causing financial stress to the family, we encourage them to do so.

Most families, however, choose to assist with fundraising. The fundraisers have not been determined at this point, so we would like the families going to consider some possible options and then assist by leading these efforts according to Diocesan policies.

We do offer scholarships for the trip based on need. If this is an option a student would like to pursue we ask that they speak to Hiedi Touney, Parish Life Director. All requests are kept confidential. Hiedi is available to meet with families to discuss the conference, costs, and fundraising as their schedules allow.

No matter what portion the family pays, all students, students' parents and chaperones are expected to participate in the fundraising effort which is an expression of caring for our Christian family.
