Online Vacation Bible School

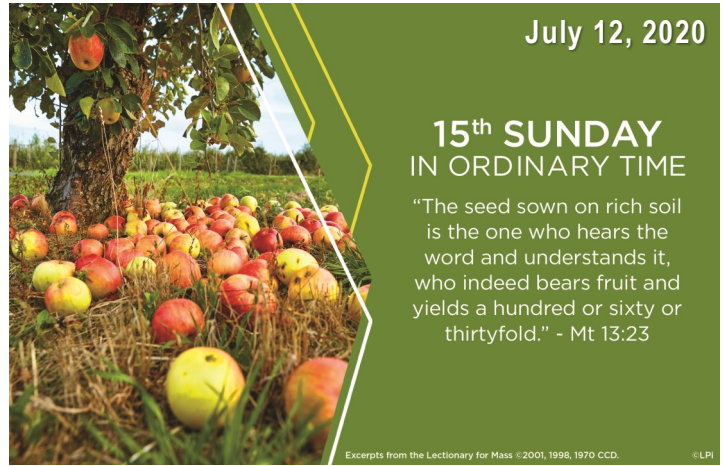
