**The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue**

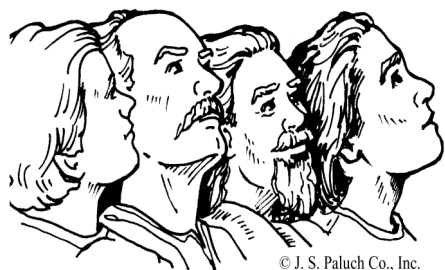
