

Pax Christi Garden Plot Rules

1. Garden plots will be available by May 1st depending on weather and soil conditions after registration has been received at Pax Christi Church.
2. Garden plots will be tilled for you in the spring after you have been assigned a plot.
3. Garden plots should be kept clean and free of weeds. This includes the adjacent area bordering other sections of the garden. Failure to maintain your garden plot after warning will result in forfeiture of your garden plot. Poorly maintained plots will be tagged and written notice sent to the gardener. If it is not cleaned up within five days of notice, the garden plot be cleaned up and you will lose your plot.
4. No structures will be allowed.
5. No fertilizers, insecticides will be used that will in any way detrimentally affect adjacent gardens or grass area.
6. You may reserve a plot for one season and you will have to give notice by April 1st if you plan to use the plot again. You will need to sign the Pax Christi Garden rules agreement each season.
7. Garden plots will be cleared and cleaned out by October 15th. All crops must be harvested by this time. All stakes, tomato cages, twine etc. must be removed by this time. If garden plots are not cleared by October 15th, use of the garden plot in the future may be denied.
8. It is important that you always respect the rights of others and appreciate the fact that this land has been made available for your personal use.
9. Pax Christi Church will not be responsible for any loss or damage to the contents of the garden plot.
10. Gardeners are responsible for providing and using personal protective equipment such as gloves, eye protection, hats, sun screen, proper foot covering and so forth as needed.
11. No illegal plants will be allowed.
12. Please make every effort to follow these garden guidelines. It will help ensure everyone will have a successful and enjoyable gardening experience.
13. Please use the compost bins for compost and not your trash!!
