

## The First Luminous Mystery The Baptism of Christ

*Proclaim the scripture verse before each Hail Mary*

1. Jesus said, "Baptize me, John." *Mt 3:13*
2. John said, "It is you who should be baptizing me." *Mt 3:14*
3. "We must fulfill all righteousness." *Mt 3:15*
4. So Jesus went down into the waters.
5. And when he emerged a voice was heard from heaven. *Mt 3:16, Mk 1:11, Lk 2:22*
6. "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." *Mt 3:17, Mk 1:11, Lk 2:22*
7. And the Holy Spirit descended upon him in the form of a dove. *Mt 3:16, Mk 1:10, Lk 2:21*
8. And John said, "Behold the lamb of God." *Jn 1:36*
9. And the Holy Spirit drove him out into the desert. *Mt 4:1, Mk 1:12, of Lk 4:1*
10. And there he did battle with demons and wild beasts. *Mk 1:13*

## The Second Luminous Mystery The Wedding Feast at Cana

*Proclaim the scripture verse before each Hail Mary*

1. Now there was a wedding feast in Cana. *Jn 2:1*
2. And the mother of Jesus was there. *Jn 2:2*
3. So too were Jesus and some of his disciples. *Jn 2:2*
4. And the mother of Jesus turned to him and said, "They have no wine." *Jn 2:3*
5. Jesus responded, "Woman, how does your concern affect me?" *Jn 2:4*
6. "My hour has not yet come." *Jn 2:4*
7. And she turned to the wine stewards and said, "Do whatever he tells you." *Jn 2:5*
8. Jesus instructed them to fill the jars with water. *Jn 2:7*
9. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." *Jn 2:8*
10. Having tasted it he said, "You have saved the best wine for last." *Jn 2:10*

## The Third Luminous Mystery The Proclamation of the Kingdom

1. "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." *Mt 4:17*
2. "My Kingdom is not of this world." *Jn 18:36*
3. Jesus said, "As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.'" *Mt 10:7*
4. "If your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. Better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into Gehenna." *Mk 9:47*
5. "The Kingdom of Heaven is like a mustard seed." *Mt 13:31, Mk 4:31, Lk 13:18*
6. "But if it is by the finger of God that I drive out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you." *Lk 11:20*
7. "The Kingdom of God is like a merchant in search of fine pearls. And when he finds a pearl of great price he goes and sells all that he has and buys that pearl." *Mt 13:46*
8. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." *Lk 18:17*
9. "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." *Mt 13:44*
10. "Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit." *Jn 3:5*

## The Fourth Luminous Mystery The Transfiguration

*Proclaim the scripture verse before each Hail Mary*

1. Jesus took Peter, James and John up a high mountain. *Mt 17:1, Mk 9:2, Lk 9:28*
2. And there he was transfigured before them. *Mt 17:2, Mk 9:2, Lk 9:28*
3. His countenance changed and his clothes became dazzling white. *Mt 17:2, Mk 9:3, Lk 9:29*
4. On either side of him appeared Moses and Elijah. *Mt 17:3, Mk 9:4, Lk 9:30*
5. They were speaking with him about his upcoming exodus. *Lk 9:31*
6. And Peter said, "Lord, it is good that we are here. Let us build three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But he did not know what he was saying. *Mt 17:4, Mk 9:5, Lk 9:33*
7. While he was still speaking a cloud came and covered them. *Mt 17:5, Mk 9:7, Lk 9:34*
8. They were filled with great fear and a voice came from the cloud and said, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Listen to him." *Mt 17:5, Mk 9:7, Lk 9:35*
9. When they looked up they saw no one but Jesus. *Mk 9:8, of Lk 9:36*
10. And he gave them strict instructions to tell no one of this until he had risen from the dead. And they asked each other what "risen from the dead" meant. *Mk 9:9-10*

## The Fifth Luminous Mystery The Institution of the Eucharist

*Proclaim the scripture verse before each Hail Mary*

1. "I am the bread of life: whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." *Jn 6:34*
2. "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever." *Jn 6:51*
3. "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood you shall not have life within you." *Jn 6:53*
4. "The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." *Jn 6:53*
5. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me and I in him." *Jn 6:54*
6. "And I will raise him up on the last day." *Jn 6:54*
7. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. *Jn 6:55*
8. Then many of his disciples who were listening said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" *Jn 6:60*
9. And he took the bread in his hands, blessed and broke it and said, "This is my body." *Mt 26:26, Mk 14:22, Lk 22:19*
10. Then he took the cup and said, "This is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be shed for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins." *Mt 26:27-28, Mk 14:24, Lk 22:20*
