FROM FR. JOE...

Several months ago, in his role as Vocations Director, Fr. Stitt invited me to help him lead a discernment pilgrimage to Rome. (How could I say no to an invitation like that?) We are leaving this Tuesday evening (June 2), and will return by way of Montréal the afternoon of June 11. We'll be traveling with two of our diocesan seminarians and four young men who are discerning a call to the priesthood. Please keep our pilgrimage in your prayers, as you will be in mine.

Long after Fr. Stitt and I had reserved plane tickets and rooms in Italy, the Diocese informed me that they were arranging for Fr. Justin to take part in an acculturation program for foreign priests serving in the U.S., June 1-5. Please pray, too, for him, Fr. Tojo (parochial vicar in Massena), and all taking part in that program at the Queens Campus of St. John's University.

Readers paying close attention will have already noticed: *there will be no priests in Malone from the afternoon of Tuesday, June 2, until the morning of Saturday, June 6.* We certainly would have never planned it this way, but these two out-of-town ventures were scheduled independently of each other.

Fr. Howard Venette (of Constable/Westville/Trout River) and Fr. John Looby (of Chateaugay/Burke) have graciously and generously agreed--in addition to regular duties in their own parishes--to cover daily Masses here, the emergency pager, and any funerals from St. André's which may arise during these three days. When you see them, be sure to heartily thank them! (Please note that there will be no adoration or confessions this Thursday evening.)

Fr. Justin will take over when he gets back from NYC. I'm sure you'll take good care of him (as he'll take good care of you) until I return from Rome. *Arrivederci!*

**We want to remind everyone of the importance of

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
