If you've been anywhere near Notre Dame Church in the past couple of weeks, then you've certainly noticed something missing: **the former Malone Adult Center building is no more.** With that structure gone, you can really get a sense of the size of the lot on which it stood—and, although there are no specific plans at this time (other than to try to plant some grass on the spot), it's now much easier to see the potential for what might occupy that plot of land in the future. While the asbestos abatement in the old building cost far, far more than anticipated, we saved a whole bunch of money on the cost of demolition thanks to the VERY generous offer to help (at no charge to us) from the following municipalities: Franklin County, the Town of Bangor, the Town of Bellmont, the Town of Burke, the Town of Malone, and the Village of Malone. *We're so incredibly grateful!*

Speaking of things missing: **the annual Assembly of Priests** of the Diocese of Ogdensburg is taking place this week, so your parish priests will be away for a few days. Please pray for us as we gather in Alexandria Bay to reconnect with one another and enjoy retreat conferences presented by the Archbishop of New York, Cardinal Timothy Dolan.

HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL

Since the year that the school opened its doors in September of 1989, parents have indicated the following reasons for sending their children to Holy Family School. We would like share some of them with you over the next few weeks. If you are interested in the unique education at Holy Family School, please call Mrs. Marianne Jadlo at 518-483-4443 or email her at hfsprincipal@hfsmalone.org.

Let us pray. *We pray with our children at the usual times - bedtime and mealtime. But we also try to remember to pray throughout the day, when we see an ambulance or when a family member needs prayers. At Holy Family School, they'll say morning prayers, Grace, and closing prayer. We remember well how, when the Challenger exploded, our principal led us in prayer. My parents, who attended Catholic School, remember praying when President Kennedy was assassinated, or when the World Trade Center collapsed on 9-11. Everyone in Catholic schools everywhere stopped their lessons and prayed. When tragedy occurred at Holy Family School everyone prayed: when precious 4th Grader Naomi Bettez died in a tragic car accident, when respected counselor Karen Borden-Clark was killed, when middle school student David Crossman died suddenly, and when loving librarian Sister Rita Frances, GNSH died, the faculty, staff, students prayed. We hope our children will turn to God in times of need.*

Put a value on education. *We want our children to have a quality education steeped in the Gospel Message of Christ. We have noticed that several of the altar servers in the area parishes are students from HFS. Several HFS students, who go on to graduate from area district schools, have consistently scored in the top 15 of their graduation class. The graduating classes traditionally exceed the local, state and national level in studies beyond high school. Holy Family School graduates excel in high school in the areas of academics and sports, and are leaders in such clubs as Speech and Debate, high school musicals and in the National Honor Society. We want our children to have the qualities to reach those milestones. The faith connection is a valued bonus to the quality education our children receive at Holy Family School.*
