From Fr. Joe...

By the time you read this, **Catholic Charities** should have completed packing up its office at St. John Bosco and begun to settle in at its new location on Raymond Street. During their 11 years of renting space from our parish, we have developed a good working relationship in the service of our neighbors in need—a relationship that certainly does not come to an end as they move into their new offices. We pray for a smooth transition as Catholic Charities begins this new chapter here in Malone!

For years, Catholic Charities has managed the **Good Samaritan Food Pantry** out of its office at St. John Bosco. But all along, the Food Pantry has been a ministry of our parish, with funding coming from our St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store, as well as from grants and donations. We thank Catholic Charities for the great good they've done in our name...but with this move, the operations of the Food Pantry now falls 100% to St. André's. **We are in need of volunteers to manage and staff the food pantry.** We don't know just yet exactly what shape such volunteer services will take, but we do know the need is great and that, as Catholics, Christ calls us to feed the hungry in our midst. The Food Pantry will offer limited services for several weeks as we work things out, getting training from the Food Bank of CNY and visiting other food pantries to learn from them (no need to reinvent the wheel). Won't you consider helping? If you're willing and able, please call the parish office.

Speaking of the parish office...with the space now empty at St. John Bosco, **we will be moving our offices to Rennie Street** over the next month or two. With the closure of St. Joseph's, and looking ahead to its eventual sale, we need to leave our Main Street location. The move should save us some money (our current office space is much bigger than we need right now), and help to make clear St. André's commitment to be the Catholic parish for all of Malone—not just one neighborhood or another. Consideration is also being given to offering some of the weekday Masses at St. John Bosco Oratory once we've moved. Stay tuned...

With the sale of St. Mary's Oratory in Lake Titus nearly complete, **we have some pews in need of a good home.** They're rustic (probably from 1925 when the church was built), but sturdy and a nice memento. We're making them available to individual parishioners first, so let us know if you're interested. Donations will be gladly accepted.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Joseph Giroux to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
