After some discussion, it was determined that the weekly Mass schedule beginning in September will be 12:05PM, Monday thru Friday at Notre Dame Church. There will also be a Holy Hour Monday thru Friday at Notre Dame Church from 11:00AM until 12:00PM, and Confession will be heard every day from 11:15AM to 11:45AM at Notre Dame. The 6:45AM Mass will be celebrated on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at St John Bosco Oratory. The Novena to St. Joseph will begin the Holy Hour every Tuesday as it has been the custom. Also, please note that Confessions will no longer be heard on Saturday from 12:00PM to 12:45PM.

Starting in September, we will be switching envelope companies from Cathedral Corporation to Church Budget. This replacement will reduce the expense from \$6,000.00 to \$1,600.00 per year. If you haven't already, you will be receiving the NEW church envelopes in the mail, and will begin using these envelopes in September. I don't think you will notice much difference in the envelopes.

I want to thank everyone who had sent me sympathy notes and expressed their condolences after my Father's passing. I must say even though I was expecting it, it was still difficult and your support and encouragement meant a great deal to me.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Steven Murray to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
