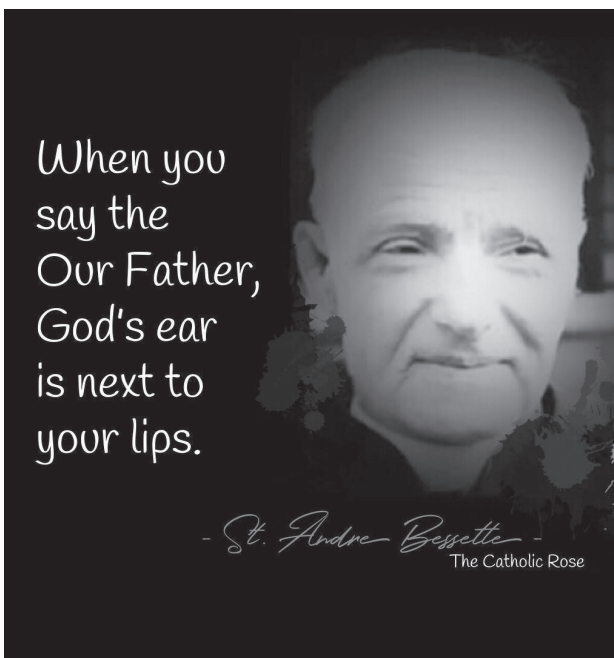

From Fr. Steve.....

Lent calls to mind many ancient traditions in the Catholic Church, one being the Stations of the Cross. The Immaculate Heart Central High School *Mystery Players* from Watertown, NY, present, in a very creative way, the centuries old stations. Meditation and contemplation on the death and resurrection of Jesus is the central mystery in the prayer of the Catholic Church. This group has performed extensively throughout New York State, and they will be performing in our parish on Saturday, March 7th at 7:30pm at Notre Dame Church. We strongly encourage everyone to attend this unique and powerful prayer experience.

Praying The Rosary is a wonderful way to deepen our relationship with God. For the past few months, parishioners have been encouraged to take and use the rosaries from the basket near the main doors of the Church. Starting today, St. André's will offer a special way to join in this prayer. A large and ornate wooden rosary, the gift of a parishioner, will be available for households to sign out and use, one week at a time. The rosary will be kept in a special basket, to the right of the statue of the Blessed Mother (and behind the book of intentions) in the front of the Church. Please bring the whole basket home with you and return it to this spot the following week.

- **WHO?** All parishioners, individuals as well as families.
- **WHAT?** In addition to the large rosary for group prayer, the basket will include smaller rosaries and simple directions for how to pray this prayer.
- **WHEN?** The basket may be signed out before/after any weekend Mass and returned at the same time the next weekend.
- **HOW?** Please write your name and phone number in the spiral notebook near the basket so that the parish can keep track of where the rosary is.
- **WHY?** Sharing the rosary among our parish households is a way of sharing prayer. For this reason, we ask that households remember the parish intention as well as your own, as you use this rosary. This is the same intention we pray for each Sunday: for an increase of vocations to the priesthood, to the Sacrament of Matrimony, and to the consecrated life.



Please join us for a parish mission in conjunction with St. Mary's in Brushton and St. Francis in Constable. Fr. John R. Yonkovic, Pastor of St. Agnes Church in Lake Placid, will be the presenter. He is a great preacher and it will be well worth your time and effort.

The Mission will begin Monday March 30th at St. Mary's in Brushton, then Tuesday March 31st at Notre Dame Church in Malone, followed by Wednesday April 1st at St. Francis of Assisi in Constable.

FOSTER GRANDPARENT PROGRAM

Catholic Charities of the Diocese hosts a Volunteer Program that may interest you. The Corporation for National and Community Service is a federally funded agency that has built volunteer-based programs over 50 years and counting. This program is right in your backyard. The Foster Grandparent Program of Northern New York has a purpose and it is to provide opportunities for low income persons aged 55 and older, to provide person to person services in health, education, and the welfare of children ages 21 and below. Foster Grandparents are placed in a classroom setting with a child or children who are in need of emotional support, development of basic learning skills, to provide friendship, companionship, encouragement, individual attention, and unhurried help. The Foster Grandparent also receives a small non-taxable stipend bi-weekly that cannot be held against any current benefits you may already have and you also get paid mileage for your travel. You receive paid holidays, vacations, sick and personal leave. The program currently has 40 volunteers and serves more than 100 kids per year. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

Making a report to the Diocese of Ogdensburg in no way means that you should not make a report to police or child protective agencies.

Low gluten hosts are available at each of our churches. If you or a loved one require a low gluten host for medical reasons, please see the priest *at least 5 minutes before Mass* to make arrangements for Holy Communion.



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized should contact Rev. Steven Murray to make arrangements for the date and for a program of preparation. Parents are highly encouraged to make arrangements at least three months before the child is born, as the Catholic Church encourages Baptism for infants as soon as possible after birth. Adults and older children (seven years or older) interested in Baptism or entering into full communion with the Catholic Church should inquire about the program of preparation (R.C.I.A.: the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

A Catholic wishing to be married in one of our churches should contact one of the priests at least six months prior to the desired date in order to begin making arrangements. A program of preparation is required. The parish should be contacted before any other plans are made—for example, the wedding reception.

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

For those preparing for surgery, nursing home residents, or the homebound, contact one of the parish priests to make arrangements to be anointed. For those in the hospital (especially in the event of an emergency), ask the hospital staff to contact the priest on call.
