

## Mass Attendees Guidelines

Please plan to arrive early to allow time to enter church with the new procedures. Per CDC requirements, we will need to stop admitting attendees once we meet the 33% maximum occupancy.

Side doors will not be unlocked, everyone will need to enter through the main/center doors.

When possible park vehicles every other space. ALL handicap spaces may be used.

When in the parking lot or on the sidewalks, non-family members must maintain six (6) feet social distancing.

Face mask/covering must be worn when on Good Shepherd property

Doors to church will be propped open for your convenience with volunteers there to check your temperature with a non-touch thermal scanner. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or greater will be asked not to attend. The volunteer may inquire about other symptoms. Entry to church will be stopped once Mass begins.

After entering the Gathering Area go to one of the three doors into the Worship Space, you will be assisted by ushers to find appropriate seating for your family. No congregating will be allowed in the Gathering Area, parishioners will need to go directly to their seats. The Gathering area will not have seating available (everyone must be seated in the Worship Space). ALL non-family members will need to maintain three (3) empty seats between the next person or group. Every other row has been marked as "no seating allowed" in order to maintain the CDC requirements of six (6) feet separation. Once Mass is over, please exit without gathering, through whatever door is convenient and as always please maintain six (6) feet social distancing.

Ushers will direct each row when to proceed to receive Communion. If you choose not to receive Communion, please file out of your row so no one will need to scoot by you. You may go through the line or circle around to wait for people to refill the row. There will be markings and a path on the floor to help you to maintain the six (6) feet social distancing.

Only four (4) people will be allowed in the Sacristy at a time. If you are scheduled to assist in a ministry, the sign-up sheet will be located on a stand near the video monitor in the Gathering Area. A volunteer will check you in as you pick up your Crosses/badges/etc. which will be available on a table under the video monitor.

Only one (1) person may be in the restroom at a time.

Only six (6) will be allowed in the Chapel at any time. Chairs are positioned six (6) feet apart.

- No hymnals, song sheets or bulletins will be available
- Holy water fonts will be empty
- Low Gluten host position will be in its normal location, near the Ambo
- Hand sanitizing stations will be located at the two entrances and throughout church
- No physical contact during the Lord's Prayer or during the Sign of Peace
- Communion is only in the form of Bread & given only in the bare hand with no words spoken
- Offertory baskets will be placed at the entrance of church; no baskets will be passed
