## 8<sup>th</sup> grade Confirmation Service requirements:

According to Diocesan guidelines for Confirmation, preparation for the Sacrament is devoted to reflection, prayer, service, and discipleship.

St. Helen Parish requires a dedicated acts of service for each of the 2 years leading up to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. This requirement flows from our understanding of "catechesis" as including "leading to service."

Confirmation candidates will sign up for their choice of **Service to the Church**. A commitment for the school year is expected. \*Altar serving will be accepted along with completing #1.

- 1) Volunteer for "A Night in Bethlehem" Christmas event in December. Volunteer for service projects with Kendal/ Youth Ministry or Youth in Action days
- 2) Volunteer to be a reader at Mass (training provided) or a Greeter at Mass
- 3) If you play an instrument, or sing, volunteer for the church choir, or youth group with Kendal.
- 4) Volunteer for the Church Nursery on Sunday mornings
- 5) Volunteer to be a teen assistant with religion classes on Sunday mornings.

- \* What was the most memorable part of this Service?
