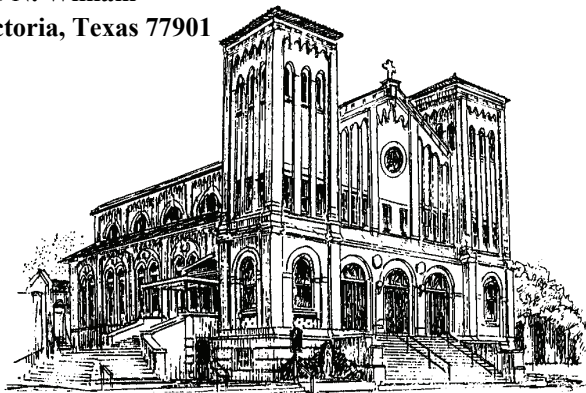

September 2018 – Combined Special Collection

The Catholic Communication Campaign (CCC): This collection communicates the Gospel through Catholic social media activities and enriches our faith through television, radio, social media, podcasts, and print media. Fifty percent of the collection supports local communication efforts such as televised Masses and diocesan newspapers. The other fifty percent supports the production of national media programming that offers a slice of Catholic life in the United States.

Black and Indian Missions: Mandated by the III Plenary Council in 1884, the 134-year-old National Collection for Black and Indian people continues as the embodiment of the Church's concern for evangelizing the Black and Indian peoples of the United States. The funds are distributed as grants to dioceses throughout the United States, supporting and strengthening evangelization programs which otherwise would cease. The Collection was formerly known as The Black and Indian Home Mission Collection.

The Catholic University of America: Provides funding for academic scholarships at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC in response to the commitment made by the bishops at its foundation in 1887. It is the only U.S. university with Pontifical faculties. Students are enrolled from all 50 states and almost 100 countries in 12 schools.
