From the Pastor...

All children of the parish are welcome to participate in the Children's liturgy program.

2. SALE OF LAND AND CHURCH BUILDINGS: I am waiting on a report from the Archdiocesan Business office, for the final report as they handle the legal aspect of the land and building sales. I hope to have in the next week or so, once received it will be posted in the bulletin.
