All are welcome to attend and meet our new Archbishop. A Reception to follow after the liturgy. It would be nice to have a large group of parishioners present at this mass. If you have never attended the installation of an Archbishop I would really encourage you to attend as it is a beautiful mass with many ancient rites, through which Bishop Hundt, becomes the Archbishop taking possession of the Archdiocese.
