During this time of Confirmation preparation, the Church requires that you actively “do for others” as a Disciple of the Lord.

What do I need to do?

Participate in outreach projects of your choice. This can be doing service for your Parish such as Trunk-or-Treat, Craft Shows, Nick’s Knights, serving at Mass, etc. This can also be doing service at a charitable organization in your community such as a soup kitchen, Habitat for Humanity, a tutoring program, etc.

What if I am not sure about the choice I have in mind?

How many service hours do I need?

The focus is on HELPING, not the number of hours. But a minimum of 20 hours is expected.

What do I do once my service hours are completed?

1. Complete the Service Hours Log for each individual project you complete. This includes getting the name, signature, and phone number of the adult from the organization that supervised your service.
2. Make a copy of the Service Hours Log and any certificates/letters you may have received. Submit the original Log and certificates/letters to George and Anna Peko **NO LATER THAN the Confirmation Retreat**. Please make sure all papers are submitted in an organized and secure way so that all paperwork for each individual stays together.

Miscellaneous notes about Service Hours:

- Parents can generally NOT sign for Service Hours for their child.
- Service done on May 1, 2018, or later is acceptable to submit for Confirmation 2019.
- Think about service you can complete with your Sponsor, friends and/or family!
