



Confirmation Saint Report

Requirements for Saint Report:

Title Page: This page should only include...

- Name of your Saint
- Your name
- Date paper is completed
- An image of your Saint

Written length of report: More than two pages of content not including your title page. (No page maximum)

Specifics: Typed, Double-spaced. No heading on report page.

Margins: 1 inch on top, bottom, left and right

Font: Times New Roman

Font Size: 12 pt.

Content: Include the following Information. You are welcome to be creative and write a short story from the perspective of this saint, and include the below details.

- Dates of time period this saint lived.
- What is known about this saint? What are they most known for?
- Stories from this saint's life.
- How did this person have an active prayer life?
- Patronage?
- Why is this person a saint?
- Why did you choose this saint?
- How can this saint help you to follow Jesus?
- How can this saint help you to prepare for Confirmation?

Sources Page/Bibliography: Required

You will need **at least two sources** as references for your paper. They can be a printed (book source), or the internet. If you use a website, be sure to include the FULL web address as the source. If one of your sources is a book, include the title, author or editor, publisher and publishing date. List your sources on a Bibliography or Sources Page.

You must write this paper in your own words! If you use text directly from another source, you must cite this source and use quotations marks around the quoted text.

Suggested Sources: Wikipedia is not an acceptable source.
